- I. President Don Wright called the meeting to order. He said the number of new, reported COVID cases in Citrus County is 80 per day, and in Marion County, it's 112 per day. These numbers are cause for worry. He proposed the Executive Committee recommend that masks be mandatory in the sanctuary and optional outdoors, a recommendation of the Safety Committee. He said Gordon and the entire Media and Technology Committee met and stated they do not feel safe operating the equipment without mandatory masking.

Don also said the Safety Committee had met and endorsed the policy to make masks mandatory in the sanctuary and optional outdoors.

Don moved and Margo seconded that the committee recommend there be mandatory masking in the sanctuary and optional making outdoors. The motion passed 5-0. The recommendation will go to the board for a vote at the July 11 meeting.

Don also discussed the Safety Committee's report, focusing on the need to develop responses to COVID, to the potential for shooters, and responses for emergencies, including fires, accidents, and weather events. He said members of the committee would be meeting with a representative of ADT.

He said most UUAs have a safety plan and a Safety Committee.

The committee agreed to adjourn.
